

The repair and painting of the center pews is now complete. Now, work is being done to remove the first 2 rows in order to expand the performance space at the front of the Meetinghouse.



In the back center of the photo is the hole cut in the wall that will be the new handicapped accessible entrance. You can also see the recently added floor (where there had been a hole looking into the church's basement).



Work has begun on the entrance way of the Meetinghouse, including repair to the walls and twin stairways leading to the second level.
